



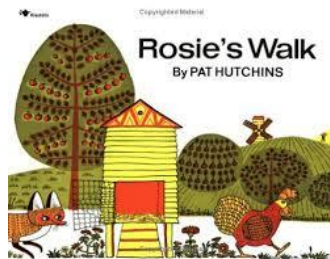
**April 24 – April 28, 2017
